Prospective Bidders may submit a bid without currently being in the 'First, Verify' Prequalification system, however acceptance of a bid is contingent upon subsequent qualification.**

Proposals and all supporting instruments must be submitted on the forms supplied by the Owner. Ultimate selection will be based upon pricing, technical capabilities, past performance and experience of bidders, as well as other factors deemed relevant by Owner.

Plans, specifications and construction drawings, together with all necessary forms, may be obtained from the owner Sho-Me Power Electric Cooperative, P.O. Box D, Marshfield, Missouri 65706. Beginning November 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2017, the plans, specifications and construction drawings may be examined at the office of the owner prior to the bid opening date and will be available for shipping.
