Dear Bidder:

Sealed proposals for construction of the Richland Crew Facility, consisting of a building, grading, fencing & heating, located in Pulaski County, will be received by Sho-Me Power Electric Cooperative, Marshfield, Missouri, on or before 11:30 A.M. Central Standard Time, May 21, 2018 at the cooperative office. The proposals will be publicly opened and read.

All bidders are required to be approved by First Verify before the contract will be awarded. Also, please be aware of new insurance requirements as stated below:

Contractor shall obtain General Liability Insurance to insure and protect Sho-Me from all risks of liability assumed by Contractor under this agreement, with limits of \$5,000,000 as to any one claim and \$5,000,000 as to any one occurrence for property damage and with limits of \$5,000,000 as to any one claim and \$5,000,000 as to any one occurrence for personal injury and death. If you are unable to obtain insurance with the limits stated, you must provide a written explanation of why you are unable to comply with this provision for Sho-Me Power's consideration.
